FOURTH ROUND OF THE ROAD RACING EUROPEAN CHAMPIONSHIP IN GROBNIK - RIJEKA

After the cloudy day of yesterday, a sunny day welcomed the numerous spectators for the Road Racing European Championship event held in Grobnik - Rijeka (Croatia). All categories were extremely fought.

In the 125 cc. class, Michele Conti, who obtained the best time on qualifying practices and who was protagonist of a spectacular fall, managed to start with a special bandage on his leg and classified seventh. The race was won by the Czech Igor Kalab (Aprilia) followed by the Italian Gabriele Gnani (Gnani) and the Dutch Joey Litjens (Honda). Fourth the Spanish Esteve Rabat Bergada (Honda) and fifth the Hungarian Attila Magda (FGR).

The 250 cc. class was won by the Spanish Alvaro Molina (Aprilia) followed by the Austrian Yves Polzer (Aprilia) and the Bulgarian Alexander Todorov (Yamaha). Fourth was the Swedish Nicklas Cajback (Yamaha) and fifth the Dutch Patrick Lakerveld (Honda)

In the Supersport 600 cc class, victory of the Italian Gilles Boccolini (Kawasaki) in front of the Croatian Loris Valjan (Honda), the Italian Guglielmo Tarrizo (Honda). Fourth the Slovenian Bostjan Pintar (Yamaha) and fifth the Italian Alessio Aldrovandi (Honda). However, after some technical verifications, Boccolini was disqualified for motorcycle irregularities. Therefore, victory went to Loris Valjan.

Victory of Luka Nedog (Honda) in the Superstock 600 class.

In the Women category, victory of the Italian Alessia Polita in the 600 cc class and of the Italian Samuela De Nardi in the 1000 cc class.

The provisional rankings see the Italian Michele Conti first with 65 points, followed by the Czech Igor Kalab with 61 points, the Austrian Michael Ranseder with 50 points, the Dutch Joey Litjens with 39 points and the Italian Andrea Boscoscuro with 30 points.

In the 250 cc class, the provisional rankings see the dominion of the Spanish Alvaro Molina with 75, followed by the Austrian Yves Polzer with 52 points, the Dutch Patrick Lakerveld with 44 points, the Italian Claudio Zanette with 33 points and the Swedish Andreas Martensson with 28 points.

In the not very crowded Supersport 600 cc class, the Italian Guglielmo Tarrizzo leads the provisional rankings with 61 points and Luca Nedog is first in the Superstock 600 cc.

In the Women category, two Italian, Alessia Polita (600 cc class) and Samuela De Nardi (1000 cc class), lead the respective provisional rankings.
