Paola Cazzola and Chiara Valentini, the two pilots of the Ducati Motor Y2K Team, will be among the more than 25 female riders fighting for the podium on Sunday, May 15, on the Vallelunga circuit (Rome), the site of the first European Women's Cup.

This is the first European trophy for female riders. It has been organised by the Italian motorcycle club Motocicliste.net and the French association Women's Project Sports, with the support of the European Motorcycling Union (UEM).

The following two categories will compete in the race and there will be two separate classifications.

- "600" (four cylinders up to 600cc and two cylinders up to 750cc)

- "1000" (four cylinders above 600cc and two cylinders above 750cc)

Both categories will follow Superstock 2005 regulations (600 and 1000) as published by the UEM.
